

DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

To preserve fair competition, ensure equal conditions for all competitors, and protect the reputation of IBFF FIT KIDS, the following regulations shall apply:

1. Every competitor, coach, club, and official is required to comply with the Federation's rules, the principles of good sportsmanship, and all decisions made by the event organizer.
2. A competitor who qualifies for the European Championship or the World Championship/World Final through an official IBFF FIT KIDS qualifying event must compete with the same registered choreography that earned the qualification, unless an official exception has been approved by the Federation.
3. A qualification obtained in a competitor's home country is valid exclusively for the corresponding IBFF FIT KIDS European Championship, World Championship, or World Cup, and may not be transferred to other competitions or other federations.
4. A competitor who performs the same choreography at qualifying events organized by another federation for the same championship or the same competitive season may lose the right to participate in the IBFF FIT KIDS European Championship, World Championship, or World Cup.
5. Providing false information, submitting forged documents, violating age category regulations, failing to comply with competition rules, or displaying unsportsmanlike conduct shall result in disqualification.
6. Any conduct that damages the reputation of the IBFF FIT KIDS Federation, the event organizer, judges, or other participants may result in disqualification, suspension, or a ban from future IBFF FIT KIDS events.
7. All disciplinary matters shall be decided by the IBFF FIT KIDS Disciplinary Committee. The Committee's decision shall be final.
8. Coaches are responsible for reading these Regulations in full and ensuring they are familiar with all rules and requirements.
9. Entries for the European Championship, World Championship, or World Cup may only be submitted by the National President or a person officially authorized by the National President.
10. Any violation of these Regulations or any inappropriate, offensive, or unsportsmanlike conduct by a coach, parent, or competitor during an event shall result in the suspension of the entire club for a minimum period of one (1) year. Any decision regarding continued membership in the Federation shall be made exclusively by the Federation Presidents.

11. Demonstrating, prompting, or coaching a choreography while the athlete is performing on stage is strictly prohibited and shall result in the immediate disqualification of the competitor.
12. Any verbal abuse, insults, or offensive behaviour directed at judges by a coach shall result in permanent expulsion from the IBFF FIT KIDS Federation.
